John was born on November 11 1919 in Musselborough, Edinburgh Scotland as the son of Mary T. Brown, of London, Ontario.

He was a truck driver and member of the Presbyterian Church.

He enlisted on July 16 1940 in Hamilton Ontario and he went in 1941 overseas to Jamaica and then on July 28 1943 overseas to the UK and he went thereafter on July 23 1944 to France.

John was killed in action on Saturday April 14 1945 age 25 during the battle of Friesoythe in Germany. He was temporarily buried there and he was reburied on March 9 1946 in Holten.

His Medals were: 1939-45 Star; France Germany Star; Defence Medal; War Medal; CVSM & Clasp.

He served with the Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders of Canada.
