

## Dies Of Wounds

Official word from Ottawa has been received by Gilbert C. Young's Cove Road, that brother, Cpl. Robert Theodo. Cole, died as a result of wound received in action against the enemy on the western front. He was wounded on April 21. Cpl. Cole enlisted for service in March, 1940, and served in Canada and Labrador prior to going overseas in September, 1943. He went into action in France in July of last year and had also seen action in Belgium, Holland and Germany. The son of the late Fred and Maria Cole, he is survived by five brothers, Carey Cole, Montreal, Frank Cole, Cole's Island, N. B., James Cole, Saint John, Gilbert Cole, at home, and Pte. Herbert Cole overseas; five sisters, Mrs. Harry Barton, Cole's Island, Mrs. Violet Elliott, Saint John, Mrs. John Gilbert, Long Creek, Florence Cole, at home, and Helen Cole, Sussex.
