Pte Frank Ivan Dougan



Frank was born on November 12 1919 in Donaldston Prince Edward Island, the son of John and Florence Ellen Dougan of Bedford Prince Edward Island. His brothers were Red, Thomas, Patrick, Joseph, John, Vincent, Fredrick, Eminelt, Maurice and Charlie Dougan.

He was a farmer and member of the Roman Catholic Church.

He enlisted on October 2 1942 in Donaldston and he went thereafter on April 19 1944 overseas to the UK. He went afterwards on July 25 to France.

Frank died in a hospital in Nijmegen on Thursday May 16 1946 age 26 due to a road accident during very bad weather in Nijmegen on his way from Grave to Oldenburg Germany. He was temporarily buried then at the Canadian Cemetery in Groesbeek and he was reburied on July 16 1946 in Holten. His grave was adopted after the war by a family of Delden.

His medals were: 1939-45 Star; France Germany Star; War Medal; CVSM & Clasp.

Frank Dougan served as a driver with the 48 Canadian General Transport Coy RCASC.
