Frank was born on August 31 1921 in Vernon British Columbia as the son of Roy and Bessie Ada Perrett, of Vancouver.

His profession was a clerk he was member of the Church of England. His interest was reading and hobby playing trumpet and piano.

He enlisted on September 15 1939 in Vancouver and he went overseas to the UK on December 18 1942 and he went thereafter to Italy on July 13 1943 and he was wounded on December 5 there. And he went back again to NW Europe on March 12 1945.

Frank died of wounds on Wednesday April 25 1945 age 23 near the village of Achterveld near Barneveld and he was temporarily buried in Gorssel and he was reburied on January 4 1946 in Holten. His grave was adopted after the war by a Dutch family in Holten.

At his headstone: TO LIVE IN THE HEARTS OF THOSE WE LOVE IS NOT TO DIE

His medals were: 1939-45 Star; Italy Star; France Germany Star; Defence Medal; War Medal; CVSM& Clasp

He served with the Seaforth Highlanders of Canada.
