



|Private Walter Grant SALISBURY

Pte. Walter Grant Salisbury, son of William B. Salisbury from Hamilton has been reported killed in action on the western front on April 3, 1945 in the age of 23 years.

Pte. Salisbury enlisted for active service in 1942 and was posted overseas with an artillery unit in October 1944. Later he was transferred to the Lincoln and Welland Regiment with which he was in action through Belgium, Holland and Germany. Prior to his enlistment Pte. Salisbury was employed at the Sterling Electric Company and the Wentworth Mineral Company.
