Albert J. Selmes was born on 25 January 1925 as son of George and Agnes Mary Selmes of Saskatoon and lived in the Little Buffalo district east of Medstead, Saskatchewan. He was a farm labour when he enlisted on 12 October 1943 at Regina with The South Saskatchewan Regiment.

Albert drowned while on a recreational swim at a swimming pond at Aurich, Germany on 24 June 1945 at the age of 20.

Selmes Lake in Saskatchewan is called after him.
