Tpr. William D'Arcy Shaughnessy, 20 years old, was killed in action in Holland on April 14, 1945, according to word reaching his parents, Mr. and Mrs. W.D. Shaughnessy from Lansing, Ontario. He enlisted in June 1943. And went overseas in July 1944 with the 6th Armd. Regt. 1st Hussars. After spending three and a half months in England, he proceeded to Belgium and Holland. Born in Toronto, he attended St. Edwards School, Lansing, and De La Salle College, Oaklands. Surviving besides his parents is a brother, Louis, and a sister, Catherine, at home.
