

Trooper Arthur Alfred SHEPHERD

Trooper Arthur Alfred Shepperd, 21, of the 8th Recce Regiment, 14th Canadian Hussars, who was slightly wounded in Germany on May 2, 1945, died two days later. He had

been in action in Belgium, Netherlands and Germany. He was the son of Arthur Shepherd, a veteran of the 3rd Battalion in World War I and Mrs. Gertrude Maud Shepherd from Toronto.

Alfred "Bud" Shepherd visited the Frankland Public School in Toronto. He went into service on November 30, 1942, and after a one-year course in Dundurn, Saskatchewan, he went to Belgium on December 3, 1944. Besides his parents, Arthur Shepherd is survived by three brothers, Eric, Ralph and Paul.
