Private Thomas L. Thomas, serving with the Canadian Scottish Regiment, was killed in action on the Western Front on 14 April 1945. His parents were Mr. and Mrs. Stephen Thomas from Penticton. One of six members of the family are in the armed forces and fought in Europe. Private The Canadians who stormed the beaches of Normandy on D-day 1944, and was a dispatch rider. Thomas had a notable record in the army as an athlete and won medals for boxing, running, swimming and track and field sports.

He had lived in Penticton for about 21 years, but was born in Milton, Oregon, USA. Before joining up he was working on a ranch at Rock Creek. He was unmarried.

Thomas was 25 years old.
